As we approach our 2019 season we would like to reach out to a number of coaches, players and potential athletes to provide a better understanding of our organization and what our focus and goals are for the 2019 season.

Our athletes will still be able to fully participate in their regular school based football season and will not be asked to choose between our program and their school program.
